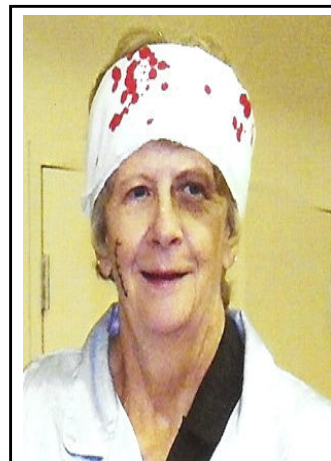
### **ELECTIONS OF OFFICERS - March**

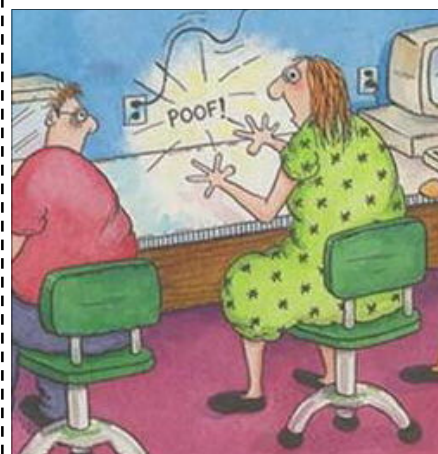
